

## Poultry Development



Poultry can play very important role in the diversification of agriculture, particularly in view of the fact that with ever increasing population, there is tremendous pressure on land. If poultry is taken up on sound basis, it can help to harness triple benefits ie additional employment income with least investment in backyard production, Over and above, poultry farming is quite and eco-friendly activity and can revert the trends of migration of rural youth.

Poultry farming is now gaining considerable momentum in this Union Territory . As poultry farming has got a good potential as a source of supplementary income and even as the main source of livelihood to the farmers, the Department has taken up the implementation of various programme for popularizing poultry farming in this Union territory. To meet the growing demand of unadulterated protein and due to the awakening among the urban populace to the importance of eggs the department started adopting all the available advanced technology to increase the annual egg production with improved birds.

### **Intensive Poultry Development Programme.**

Poultry enterprises has advanced by leaps and bounds and the backyard systems of poultry keeping in the rural families is mostly run by the women folk and the Department aims at improving the breeding quality of these birds which will ultimately increase the production of the UT to a great extent. The Intensive Poultry Development Project is an important poultry development scheme has started yielding good results commercial poultry farming. Under this scheme farmers are encouraged to set up commercial poultry farms for which all required technical assistance are provided . The primary work under this is to offer a package of input services in all aspects of poultry, which included ducks also. The main activity of prophylactic vaccination for poultry including ducks .

Diagnostic services are undertaken by conducting post mortem of specimen received from the poultry farmers. Prophylactic and post exposure treatment are provided free of cost

1. Consultancy for setting up of new poultry farms
2. Preparation of Project reports
3. Technical guidance for maintenance of poultry farms
4. Diagnosis and treatment of poultry diseases at poultry farms
5. Power Concession to poultry farms

### Livestock and Poultry Research and Extension Centre.

The farm functions as a rearing center for day old chicks both commercial and dual type. The day old chicks intended for distribution are reared unto 6-8 weeks of age and they are sold to the public at the subsidized rate. About 1000 to 2000 hybrid chicks are retained as replacement stock for the government farm to act as visual demonstration to learners and extension activity Centre. In Puducherry the farm is functioning at Kariamanickam village in Nettapakam commune

In Karaikal there are two farms one at T.R.Pattinam and other at Kottucherry. In Mahe and Yanam similar farms have been set up one at each region. These farms are functioning only as growing centres for day old chicks commercial as well as a dual purpose chicks upto 6-8 weeks of age and then distributed to the farmers and to act as demonstration and training purpose.

## Schemes implemented Under Poultry Development

1. Distribution of dual purpose poultry to farmers for backyard poultry production.
2. Distribution of turkey poult to farmers for backyard poultry production
3. Maintenance of farm stock (commercial layer stock) at Government Poultry Farm for demonstration and training.
4. Distribution of layer pullet with cage and feed to farmers for egg production at backyard.(Modified Scheme announced by Hon'ble Minister on the Floor of the Assembly)
5. Setting up of Rabbit and Japanese quails units scheme with 75% subsidy. (New Scheme announced by Hon'ble Minister on the Floor of the Assembly)
6. Setting up of broiler farm at 75% subsidy – New scheme. .(New Scheme announced by Hon'ble Minister on the Floor of the Assembly)

## DISTRIBUTION OF DUAL PURPOSE POULTRY TO FARMERS FOR BACKYARD POULTRY PRODUCTION



A. Objective : To encourage egg and meat production at backyard of the farmers in U T of Puducherry

B. Scope

Assistance by way of subsidy of 50% shall be given to farmers of all category.

C. Eligibility

The beneficiary must be a resident of the Union territory of Puducherry , should possess suitable place for rearing poultry at backyard.

D. Targeted group:

All residents of Puducherry fulfilling the eligibility criteria.

A minimum of 20% of Scheduled Caste community is likely to be covered by the Scheme.

### E. Methodology of selection:

The Veterinary Assistant Surgeons of the Veterinary Dispensary of the respective regions shall recommend and issue the birds to the farmers if he is satisfied that the beneficiary shall hold and rear the poultry at his/her backyard.

**SCHEME:** The scheme envisages distribution of dual type of poultry of 6 - 8 weeks of age. The farmer will maintain the birds up to a minimum of 18 months and produce egg or meat.

SCHEME UNIT: 2-10 numbers of dual type birds can be issued to a beneficiary by the Veterinary Assistant Surgeon.

### **Pattern of Assistance**

The Department will purchase day old chicks of dual type and rear up to 6-8 weeks and workout the cost of production including all charges i.e. cost of chicks ,feed, medication vaccination and other incidentals. The worked out cost will be subsidized to 50% of the production cost and will be sold to the beneficiaries. The Department from time to time will fix the sale price as per the production cost.

### **Inspection and Health Coverage**

The Veterinary Assistant Surgeons of the respective regions of the Department of Animal Husbandry and Animal Welfare will provide for inspection and Health coverage. The Veterinary Assistant Surgeon will provide all technical guidance for the maintenance.

### **Recovery and Cancellation of Subsidy**

The beneficiary shall submit an undertaking that he/she will continue to maintain the unit. He shall not sell away shall not use the stock for the purpose other than for which the subsidy is provided.

If it is proved/found subsequently that the beneficiary is a defaulter and has misused the subsidy, the Cost of subsidy so provided shall be recovered by the Government apart from taking penal action as per law against him/ her.

### **Interpretation and clarification**

In the implementation of the Scheme, if any doubt arises with regard to the interpretation of any of the provisions of the Scheme or if any point requires clarifications, the matter shall be referred to the Director of Animal Husbandry and Animal Welfare, Puducherry and the decision of the Director shall be the final.





## 2. Distribution of turkey poults to farmers under backyard poultry production



### A. Objective:

To encourage production of poultry meat at backyard of the farmers in Puducherry

### B. Scope

Assistance by way of subsidy of 50% shall be made to farmers of all category.

### C. Eligibility

The beneficiary must be a resident of the Union territory of Puducherry. Should possess suitable place for rearing poultry at backyard.

### D. Targeted group:

All the residents of Puducherry fulfilling the eligibility criteria.

A minimum of 20% of Scheduled Caste community is likely to be covered by the Scheme.

**E. Methodology of selection:**

The Veterinary Assistant Surgeons of the Veterinary Dispensary of the respective regions shall recommend and issue the birds to the farmers if he is satisfied that the beneficiary shall hold and rear the poultry at his/her backyard.

**SCHEME:** The scheme envisages distribution of turkey poults of 6 - 8 weeks of age. The farmers will maintain the birds to a minimum of 6-12 months and produce meat.

SCHEME UNIT: 2 to 4 numbers of turkey poults can be issued to a beneficiary by the Veterinary Assistant Surgeon.

### **Pattern of Assistance**

The Department will purchase day old Turkey poults and rear up to 6-8 weeks or will purchase 6-8 weeks old turkey poults from turkey farms from neighboring States and workout the cost of production including all charges i.e. cost of chicks ,feed, medication vaccination and other incidentals. The worked out the production cost and will subsidized to 50% or will purchase 6-8 weeks old turkey poults from turkey farms from neighboring States and subsidized the cost of purchase to 50% and issue to the beneficiaries. The Department from time to time will fix the production cost.

### **Inspection and Health Coverage**

The Veterinary Assistant Surgeons of the respective regions of the Department of Animal Husbandry and Animal Welfare will provide for inspection and Health coverage. The Veterinary Assistant Surgeon will provide all technical guidance for the maintenance.

### **Recovery and Cancellation of Subsidy**

The beneficiary shall submit an undertaking that he/she will continue to function the unit. He shall not sell away the stock and infrastructure and shall not use the infrastructure for the purpose other than for which the subsidy is provided.

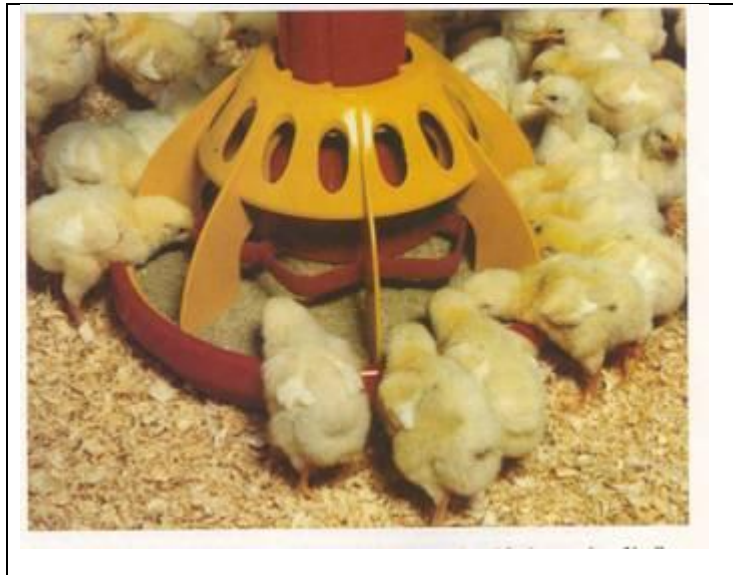
If it is proved/found subsequently that the beneficiary is a defaulter and has misused the subsidy, the Cost of subsidy so provided shall be recovered by the Government apart from taking penal action as per law against him/ her.

1. Maintenance of farm stock (commercial layer stock) at Government Poultry Farm for demonstration and training.



- The Govt. Poultry farms have been started at all regions of the U.T. of Puducherry with an objective to impart training to the farmers in Poultry keeping and to produce egg from the farm stock and supply to the public. These institutions are acting as visual demonstration units to the farmers of the region. Infrastructure develops in the farms serving for the above objective.
- At present these farms continue to serve for the purpose and infrastructure developed in the farm are being used for supply of varieties of Poultry to the farmers. The latest breeds and strains developed in the Research institutions and organizations are maintained as farm stocks and the products are supplied to the farmers and the consumers.

#### 4.SCHEME OF DISTRIBUTION OF LAYER PULLETS FOR EGG PRODUCTION AT BACKYARD



##### A. Short title, extent and commencement

The scheme shall be called the “Scheme of Distribution of 18 weeks layer pullets for egg production at backyards”.

- a. It shall be extended to all the regions of the Union territory of Puducherry .
- b. It shall be come into force with immediate effect.

##### B. Objective

To encourage egg production in Puducherry at the back yard of farmers.

##### C. Scope

Assistance by way of subsidy of 100% shall be made to farmers Below Poverty line and of 75% to other farmers with a unit of 15 layer pullets with required initial infrastructure, or namely a cage and feed for one month .

##### D. Eligibility

For being covered 100% subsidy, the beneficiary under the Scheme must be categorized as belonging to Below Poverty line and should be a resident of the Union territory of Puducherry . The beneficiary should produce a Certificate from the Revenue Authorities to that effect. For being covered by 75% subsidy, the applicant must be a resident of the Union territory of Puducherry and produce a certificate from the Revenue Authorities in proof of the same.

Targeted group:

All the residents of Puducherry fulfilling the eligibility criteria.

A minimum of 20% of Scheduled Caste community is likely to be covered by the Scheme.

Application for benefiting under the Scheme:

Application forms shall be had from Veterinary Assistant Surgeons of the respective regions. The filled in application shall be submitted along with the aforesaid documents within the period prescribed therein.

**Methodology of selection:**

The Veterinary Assistant Surgeons of the Veterinary Dispensary of the respective regions shall recommend the application for selection to the Selection Committee.

Application recommended by the Veterinary Assistant Surgeon having jurisdiction only shall be accepted.

The Selection Committee will scrutinize the applications and on satisfying itself that the aforesaid and documents have been enclosed and select the beneficiary.

**SCHEME:** The scheme envisages distribution of commercial type of layer pullets of 18 weeks of age with minimum required infra-structure and assistance upto optimum production.

SCHEME UNIT: 15 numbers of commercial layer pullets of 18 weeks of age will be supplied along with required cage accommodation and feed for 4 weeks / one month.

### **Pattern of Assistance**

Minimum basic infrastructure will be provided by the Government as follows:

- 1) Cage containing all required accessories for 15 birds
- 2) 15 numbers of layer pullets of 18 weeks of age.
- 3) Supply of 50 kgs. feed for 4 weeks

All the three input items will be supplied by the Department to the applicant after selection but shall be not be issued as cash.

The selected Below Poverty Line beneficiary will be supplied the above inputs free of cost i.e. 100% subsidy.

The selected beneficiary other than from the Below Poverty line category under the scheme shall pay an amount equal to 25% of the cost of the input to the Department and obtain the assistance.

### **Inspection and Health Coverage**

The Veterinary Assistant Surgeons of the respective regions of the Department of Animal Husbandry and Animal Welfare will provide for inspection and Health coverage. The Veterinary Assistant Surgeon will provide all technical guidance for the maintenance.

### **Recovery and Cancellation of Subsidy**

The beneficiary shall submit an undertaking that he/she will continue to function the unit. He shall not sell away the stock and infrastructure and shall not use the infrastructure for the purpose other than for which the subsidy is provided.

If it is proved/found subsequently that the beneficiary is a defaulter and has misused the subsidy, the Cost of subsidy so provided shall be recovered by the Government apart from taking penal action as per law against him/ her.

5.Scheme for setting up of Japanese quail and Rabbit units in Union territory of Puducherry under 75% subsidy



#### A. Short title extent and commencement

1. The scheme shall be called “Japanese Quail/Rabbit rearing scheme under 75% subsidy”.
2. It shall be extended to all the regions of Union territory of Puducherry .
3. It shall be come into force with immediate effect.

#### B. Objective

To encourage production of additional and alternate meat delicacies.

#### C. Scope

Assistance by way of subsidy of 75% shall be made to educated unemployed candidates for purchase of a unit of 1000 Japanese Quail or 7+3 Rabbit with required initial infrastructure.

#### D. Eligibility

For coverage under the scheme, the applicant must be educated and should have passed SSLC/ Matriculation or equivalent atleast and should possess a suitable land of 200 Square feet for Japanese Quail and 400 Square feet for Rabbit Unit. The applicant shall also submit a proof for possession of land of his own or of possession of land on lease. The applicant must be a resident of Puducherry and enclose a certificate from the Revenue authorities to that effect.

#### **Targeted group**

All educated candidates fulfilling the eligibility criteria.

A minimum percentage of 20% of Schedule Caste candidates is likely to be covered by the scheme.

Application for benefiting under the Scheme:

Application forms shall be had from Veterinary Assistant Surgeons of the respective regions. The filled in application shall be submitted along with the aforesaid documents within the period prescribed therein.

### **Methodology of selection**

The Veterinary Assistant Surgeons of the Veterinary Dispensary of the respective regions shall recommend the applications for selection to the Selection Committee.

Application recommended by the Veterinary Assistant Surgeon having jurisdiction only shall be accepted.

The selection committee will scrutinize the applications and on satisfying itself the aforesaid documents have been enclosed.

**6. Scheme for setting up of Broiler units in the Union territory of Puducherry under 75% subsidy ( New scheme)**



**A. Short title extent and commencement**

4. The scheme shall be called "Setting up of Broiler Units Scheme under 75% Subsidy".
5. It shall be extended to all the regions of Union territory of Puducherry . To start with it shall be implemented in Puducherry and Karaikal.
6. It shall come into force with immediate effect.

**B. Objective**

To encourage additional production of the cheapest meat delicacies for consumers.

**C. Scope**

Assistance by way of subsidy of 75% shall be provided to educated unemployed candidates for purchase of a unit consisting of 1000 Broiler birds with required initial infrastructure.

**D. Eligibility**

For coverage under the scheme, the applicant must be educated having passed SSLC/ Matriculation or equivalent at the least and having registered in the Employment exchange, Puducherry (proof of which shall be enclosed) of and should possess a suitable land for construction of poultry shed of 1000 Square feet for Broiler Unit. The applicant shall also submit a proof for possession of land of his own or of possession of land on lease. The applicant must be a resident of Puducherry for which a certificate from the Revenue authorities to that effect should be enclosed.

**E. Targeted group**

Educated candidates fulfilling the eligibility criteria.

A minimum of 20% of Schedule Caste candidates is likely to be covered by the scheme.

F. Application for benefiting under the Scheme:

Application forms shall be had from the Veterinary Assistant Surgeons of the respective regions. The filled in applications shall be submitted along with the aforesaid documents within the period prescribed therein.( Please prescribe it in the Application form).

## G. Methodology of selection

The Veterinary Assistant Surgeons of the Veterinary Dispensary of the respective regions shall recommend the applications for selection to the Selection Committee.

Applications recommended by the Veterinary Assistant Surgeon having jurisdiction only shall be considered for selection.

The selection committee will scrutinize the applications and on satisfying itself the aforesaid documents have been enclosed and that the requisites have been fulfilled will select the candidates for the grant.

The Veterinary Assistant Surgeons of the respective regions of the Department of Animal Husbandry and Animal Welfare will provide Health coverage and routine inspection. The Veterinary Assistant Surgeon will provide all technical guidance for the maintenance of the broiler chicks.

#### K.Recovery and cancellation of subsidy

The beneficiary shall submit an undertaking that he/she will continue to run the unit and that he shall not sell away the stock and infrastructure and that he shall not use the infrastructure for the purpose other than for which the subsidy is provided.

If it is proved/found subsequently that the beneficiary is a defaulter and has misused the subsidy, subsidy granted to him will be recovered by the Government apart from taking penal action as per law against him/ her.

#### L.Interpretation and clarification

In the implementation of the Scheme, if any doubt arises with regard to the interpretation of any of the provisions of the Scheme or if any point requires clarifications, the matter shall be referred to the Director of Animal Husbandry and Animal Welfare, Puducherry and the decision of the Director shall be final.
