NOTIFICATION

Applications are invited from the Natives / Residents of the Union Territory of Puducherry to apply for the post of Veterinary Assistant Surgeon on contract basis in the Department of Animal Husbandry and Animal Welfare, Puducherry for a period of one year (with one day break between 120 days) or till the necessity ceases, whichever is earlier as detailed below:-

2. ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS

(a). AGE

Not exceeding 35 years as on 08.08.2022, the last date for receipt of filled in applications

Age limit is relaxable in respect of OBC, SC & ST as detailed below

Category	Relaxation of upper age limit
OBC	Three Years (35 + 3)
SC / ST	Five Years (35 + 5)

(b). EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION

- i) Should possess a Bachelor's Degree in Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry or Veterinary Science from a recognized University or Institute
- ii) Should be registered with the Veterinary Council of India or State / UT Veterinary Council

(c). NATIVITY / RESIDENCE

Those who are natives of Union Territory of Puducherry by continuous residence in the UT for the last five years immediately preceding the date of notification only are eligible to apply for the posts. The applicants should enclose a fresh Nativity / Residence certificate issued by an Officer of the Department of Revenue and Disaster Management not below the rank of Deputy Tahsildar / Tahsildar.

(d). COMMUNITY

The applicants should submit a fresh Community Certificate for OBC/EWS/SC/ST obtained in the prescribed form issued by an Officer of the Department of Revenue and Disaster Management not below the rank of Deputy Tahsildar / Tahsildar. The certificate should have been issued within one year from the closing date for application for this engagement. Candidates selected under SC category should furnish Community Certificate issued under "The Constitution (Puducherry) Scheduled Castes Order, 1964 " and "The Constitution (Puducherry) Scheduled Castes Order, 2002" in respect of "Puthirai Vannan".

(e). EMPLOYMENT EXCHANGE REGISTRATION

Should be registered with Employment Exchange, Puducherry and a copy of the valid & duly renewed registration card should be enclosed.

(f). CERTIFICATE OF HEALTH

Should have sound health and body and the **candidates if selected** should submit a certificate to this effect from a Government Medical Officer.

(g). OTHER CONDITIONS

- i. The period of contract engagement will be for a period of one year (with one day break between 120 days) or till the necessity ceases, whichever is earlier.
- ii. The persons engaged on contract basis have no right to claim for permanent or regular employment in this Administration as this is purely a contractual engagement for a specific tenure period.
- iii. The persons engaged are not eligible for accommodation / residential quarters.
- iv. Canvassing of any kind will lead to disqualification and is liable for legal action.
- v. The persons engaged on contract basis will have to work at any region in the UT of Puducherry viz., Puducherry, Karaikal, Mahe and Yanam and have to work in day shifts and night shifts whenever necessary.
- vi. The persons engaged on contract basis should not have been convicted by any Court of Law and shall not have any adverse character or antecedents.
- vii. In case if any information given or declared by the candidate is found to be false or if he / she has wilfully suppressed any material information relevant to his / her appointment, he / she will be liable to be terminated from the contractual engagement and may be liable to face any action deemed fit by the competent authority.
- viii. The decision of the competent authority regarding selection of candidates will be final and no representation will be entertained in this regard.

- ix. Incomplete applications in any aspect will be summarily rejected.
- x. The competent authority reserves the right to make any changes in the engagement process.
- xi. The competent authority also reserves the right of any amendment, cancellation and changes to this advertisement as a whole or in part without assigning any reason or giving notice.
- xii. The claims of the candidates with regard to the date of birth, educational qualification, community etc., are accepted only on the information furnished by them in their application without physical verification of their claims. Their candidature therefore will be provisional at all stages and this Department reserves the right to reject any candidature at any stage, even after the selection has been made, if found unfit.
- xiii. Candidates from other states / Union Territories are not eligible to apply for the post.
- xiv. Change of address, if any, after submission of application should be intimated to the Department or otherwise the Department is not responsible for any postal delay / non delivery of letters.
- xv. The candidates should have access of their mobile phones and their e-mails from time to time for any updates prescribed in relevance to the application.
- xvi. The candidates should produce original certificates only at the time of verification.

3. METHOD OF SELECTION

Selection shall be in the order of merit i.e., percentage of marks obtained in B.V.Sc. / B.V.Sc. & AH.

4. HOW TO APPLY

Applicants fulfilling the eligibility criteria as mentioned above may download the application and the filled-in applications along with all enclosures in a sealed envelope superscribed as **“Application for the post of Veterinary Assistant Surgeon on contract basis”** should reach **“The Director, Department of Animal Husbandry and Animal Welfare, Maraimalai Adigal Salai, Puducherry – 605 001** on or before **08.08.2022 (5.00 pm)** either through post or in person.
