2. The rate should be quoted for each item separately as follows:-

3. The Tenders in sealed covers superscribing "Tender for the Purchase of old newspapers and magazines, etc." should be addressed to the Director of Information and Publicity, Puducherry so as to reach this office on or before 07.12.2023 at 4.00 PM. The tenders will be opened on the same day at 5.00 PM.

4. Tenders received after the due date and time will be rejected.

5. The intending tenderers should deposit an Earnest Money Deposit(EMD) of Rs.1,000/- (Rupees one thousand only) in cash before submission of the sealed tenders. The EMD of the unsuccessful tenderers will be refunded after the tenders are opened and successful tenderer is selected.


6. The intending tenderers may inspect the said articles during office hours on any working day with the permission of the undersigned.

7. The undersigned reserves full right either to accept or reject any or all the tenders without assigning any reason. Contravention of the rules of tender notice will result in the forfeiture of the EMD.

The successful tenderer shall arrange for the Government weighing machine or authorized by the Government to weigh the old newspapers and magazines, pay the cost thereof alongwith the applicable GST and remove the old newspapers and magazines within 48 hours from the time of the tender sale is over during office hours. Any failure to these arrangements, the EMD paid will be forfeited. Also, for the old newspapers and magazines which have been disposed off after due receipt of payment, this department will not undertake any responsibility for any loss or shortage or damage. On completion of clearance, the EMD will be refunded.

9. In case of any dispute, the decision of the Director of Information and Publicity, Puducherry, shall be final.
